We are really pleased with our 2019 drop rams. This means we are in a position to increase our offering without compromising our quality. With rigorous culling and great lambing percentages we believe our 2020 line-up is our most consistent yet. The rams visually display plenty of thickness and fat, backed up by their ASBV's, are generally moderate sized and you can see from the graph the strides we have made in the all important area of fertility over the last 8 years.

Once again there will be a selection of rams with Poll Merino genetics for those people that wish to retain more emphasis on their wool.

I think it is especially important that we are able to measure our gains. The following table shows the progress we have made over the last 8 years in important production areas.

# White Suffolks



We are really thrilled with the White Suffolk offering this year. It is a disappointment that more people will not be able to see the offering.

The White Suffolk rams are as muscular as we have had them. That combined with their length, early growth and structural correctness makes them well worth a look. New Sire Woolumbool 173980 has certainly left plenty of muscle on a moderate frame. This visual muscularity is backed up by a top 1% ASBV for muscle. He is also a trait leader for post weaning weight, low worm egg count and the eating quality traits of IMF and Shear Force.

Early growth is one of the main profit drivers of a lamb enterprise. Many of our Sires, including all 5 ram lambs we used for the 2019 drop are trait leaders for weaning weight and post weaning weight. Amongst these is 180081 a ram we retained who is also a trait leader for IMF. Others are trait leaders for lean meat yield which is a profit driver for the processors. They are 180129 our top price ram of 2019, selling to Willochra for \$10,500 and 180083 selling to Yonga Downs WA for \$7000.
